

We will gesture toward and move through acts of returning feelings and perceptions to their mythic source. Embodied, versed, ensouled, we will trace the iconographical clues surrounding us to unveil vital secrets and to discover personal ceremonies for renewal and creation. In a theater of life at play in the world, we will journey the fertile mythopoesis of Venetian legend, lore and culture through its richly laden and vastly shaded archetypal language – to sojourn in the calendar's autumn of experience with an eye and heart to sift what is deepest, most universal and lasting. Led by Dr. Bresciani with an experienced local guide via private modes of transportation over land and waters we will explore the wonders of Venice and wend our way from Venice to the Veneto – Verona, Mantua, Lake Garda – through enchanting countryside.
